

WOOD WORKING WORKSHOP AT SASI CREATIVE INSTITUTE OF DESIGN





Students from the IB Design & Technology curriculum (DP1 & DP2) participated in a one-day design workshop at the Sasi Creative Institute of Design in Myleripalayam, Coimbatore, on November 30, 2023. The workshop focused on creating a multipurpose wooden chair that doubles as a ladder for kids.

The event began in the wooden lab, where students learned about various tools, including chisel sets, jigs, and saws. A presentation on wood identification and selection followed, emphasizing functionality. Students then designed conceptual sketches and crafted mock-up models using foam boards.

Through a step-by-step process, students received hands-on training in wood cutting, sanding, polishing, and joining. The workshop aimed to bridge theoretical knowledge with practical experience, allowing students to witness the application of textbook concepts in a tangible setting.












The Group 4 project at encourages collaboration among students from different scientific disciplines. Emphasizing the process of scientific investigation, it focuses on hands-on activities, fostering resilience in the face of uncertainties. The project also highlights ethical considerations in science, promoting responsible use of scientific knowledge. Mandatory for Diploma Programme science students, the project culminates in a presentation of findings, showcasing students' growth as scientists adept at navigating interdisciplinary challenges and ethical dilemmas. In essence, it is a transformative journey, equipping students with the skills to address complexities at the intersection of science, technology, and society. By the End of Year 2, all Diploma Programme Science Students will present their findings on their project.



The Theory of Knowledge essay requires students to undertake a formal academic critical exploration of one of the six prescribed titles. These titles are formed as knowledge questions, and their primary objective is to answer the "why" behind our studies. The students are conscientiously engaged in the examination of the titles, and the acute dissection of these titles, which covered approximately one week, laid the foundation for the students' ongoing pursuit in crafting their initial draft. Further, the pursuit of clarity and precision in conveying their ideas is reflective of careful consideration of diverse perspectives and deeper understanding of the nature of knowledge.


