Students explored admission processes, academic programs, and career pathways through interactive discussions, gaining valuable insights for their higher education choices.

Industry Insights: Tirupur Textile Visit

DP students visited Tirupur's textile industry to gain firsthand insights into industrial operations, economic systems, and business strategies.
